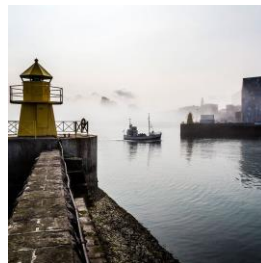

Day 1: Arrival in Iceland

Start your visit with our Airport Express scheduled transfer to Reykjavik and check in to your hotel in Reykjavik. Explore the most northerly located capital on your own.

We recommend to visit one of them any public swimming pools in Reykjavik to take a swim, relax in the hot tub, and talk to the person sitting next to you – just like the Icelanders do!

Combining the Golden Circle and Sky Lagoon, this breathtaking tour takes you on a wondrous journey through Iceland's staggeringly raw beauty. It ends with the ultimate Icelandic indulgence: a luxurious soak in Sky Lagoon, a geothermal spa where the ocean meets the sky. Go on a journey that brings you the experiences of walking among geologic marvels, witnessing an erupting hot spring, discovering a magnificent waterfall, and unwinding in an outdoor geothermal spa.

Tour Itinerary

Pingvellir National Park is located in a rift valley where the Eurasian and North American tectonic plates meet. It is a site of great historical, geological and cultural significance and has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site. Pingvellir is the birthplace of the Althing Iceland's parliament founded in 930 AD, where the nation's most powerful leaders would meet to decide on legislation and carry out brutal Viking age justice.

The tour continues across an area of picturesque scenery to the mighty Gullfoss waterfall. Once there, you can take several paths around the two tiers of cascading water to explore several vantage points. Extra time is allotted at this location for a lunch break at Gullfoss Café, where food is available for purchase. Next up is the home of "The Great Geysir" hot spring, which all geysers are named after. This area is an impressive collage of bubbling mud pools, hissing steam vents, and colorful algae deposits. Strokkur geyser puts on quite the show every few minutes blasting boiling water high up into the air.

The Sky Lagoon

Just outside Reykjavik is the Sky Lagoon, an incredible thermal spa where the ocean meets the sky at the edge of the world. It's based on using the best of Iceland from nature, beauty, wonder and warmth. The lagoon is perfect for rejuvenation and relaxation for mind, body and soul in a pure geothermal water.

7-Step Ritual

1. Start by settling in and relax at the lagoon and breathe in the fresh Icelandic air.
2. It's time for the glacier cold pool for only the bravest, leaving you with increased blood flow and tighter skin as well as a natural high!
3. Visit the sauna and it's breathtaking view.
4. Balance the heat by going slowly through the cold fog-mist space by taking a deep breath and refresh your senses.
5. Apply the signature Sky Body Scrub for a glowing skin.
6. Step into the steam and allow the moist to maximize the hydrating benefits of the body scrub.
7. Enjoy the moment in a pure gentle shower and feel the result of the ritual.

Sky Lagoon Features

The Sky Lagoon opened in May 2021 and offers a state of the art locker rooms, showers, and changing facilities, as well as a bar and restaurant area. After 2 hours of enjoying the Sky Lagoon's miraculous waters, a return transfer is waiting for you, rejuvenated and refreshed.

- Children under the age of 12 years are not allowed on this tour.

Day 3: Blue lagoon & Northern Lights Tour

Morning or early afternoon: Blue lagoon visit.

Scheduled transfer to the Blue lagoon depart every hour on the hour. Stop at the Blue lagoon for 3 hours or more, and return with the scheduled transfer to Reykjavik.

Soak in the milky blue water of the Blue lagoon rich in Silica and the Blue lagoon Algae known for its soothing effect on the skin. Take a healthy drink at the In-Water-Bar, heat up in the Sauna & Steam room, enjoy the cleansing and revitalizing powers of the silica mud, relax and experience the radiant powers of geothermal seawater.
