Itinerary:

Day 1: South Iceland highlights

Visit majestic waterfalls, black sand beaches, the basalt columns at Reynisfjara beach. Enjoy the views over mountains, volcanoes, glaciers, green farmland and the Atlantic ocean.

Plan of the day:

- **Depart from Reykjavik in the morning.**
- **Skógafoss waterfall** – get close to the cascade and walk the uncountable steps to the brim of the waterfall for an unforgettable view.
- **Reynisfjara black sand beach** – walk along the black sand beach to the basalt columns, washed out by the Atlantic ocean.
- **Dyrholaey rock arch** – take the drive to the lighthouse at Cape Dyrholaey and see the waves beating against the cliffs and natural rock arch.
- **Vik village** – explore the small village and walk to see the Reynisdrangar rocks stacks, believed to be Trolls that came ashore to late and caught by the morning sun and turned to stone.
- **Fjaðarargljúfur gorge** – walk along the canyon with its sheer walls.
- **Arrive at 18:00 at your accommodation in Kirkjubæjarklaustur/ Skaftafell/ Glacier lagoon area for a one night stay.**
- **Optional activities**
- Dinner on your own.

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Day 2: Skaftafell National Park, Vatnajökull Glacier & Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon

Travel through the spellbinding landscape of Myrdalsandur and Skeiðará sand deserts, the mosscovered lava fields. With Iceland's largest glacier Vatnajökull in view, visit Skaftafell National Park and famous Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon.

Plan of the day:

- **Depart at 09:00**
- **Skeiðarásandur** – drive again through a sand desert, the largest in Iceland and gaze upon the largest glacier, Vatnajökull.
- **Skaftafell National Park** – visit the information centre of Iceland's largest National Park.
- **Jökulsárlón Glacier lagoon** - Packed with icebergs in various shades of white and blue, the extraordinary scenery at Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon is sure to take your breath away.
- **Diamond beach** – often smaller icebergs are washed back ashore at the black sand beach, glittering like diamonds in the sun.
- **Seljalandfoss waterfall** – a picturesque waterfall where you can walk behind
- **Gljúfrabúi waterfall**, the “gorge dweller” – walk from Seljalandfoss waterfall along the rock cliff to this little gem and dare walking into the gorge for a closer look: waterproofs highly recommendet!
- **Arrive at ca. 19:00 in Reykjavik.**

Optional activities that can be added on this two day tour. Please note that only one or two activities can be added on depending on duration. For more activities, perhaps add on another day:



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- **Katla Ice Cave Jeep tour** – join a Super Jeep tour to the remote area of the Myrdalssandur sand desert and visit the secret Ice Cave of one of the outlet glaciers, only known to the locals. Operated all year round.
- **Amphibian boat tour on Glacier lagoon** – participate in a boat tour around the icebergs floating on the Glacier lagoon. Operated from 15th May to 15th October 2018
- **Zodiak boat tour on Glacier lagoon** – take an exciting tour around the icebergs in a Zodiak boat. Operated from 15th May to 15th October
- **Ice Cave in Vatnajökull area** – explore on a guided tour the natural Ice Caves in one of the outlet glaciers from the ice cap Vatnajökull. Operated from 01st November until 31st March.
- **Glacier hike on Vatnajökull** – join an exiting Glacier hike tour, easy and safe with a professional Guide.
- **Icelandic Lava Show** - Get a taste of a volcano eruption in the first and only live lava show in the world! Experience real molten lava as it is poured into the showroom.
- **Glacier hike on Solheimajökull** – take an easy glacier hike on the outlet glacier Solheimajökull and explore the ice up close.
- **Snowmobiling on Myrdalsjökull** – take a ride on a snowmobile on top of the ice cap Myrdalsjökull and enjoy the thrill of driving a snowmobile with a grand view over the south of Iceland. Please note that a valid driver´s licence is required to operate the snowmobile.
- **ATV tour into the black sand** – drive on an ATV into the black sand desert and visit the plane wreck.
- **Plane wreck in the black sand** – don´t want to walk or take an ATV? NO prob! The shuttle service to the plane wreck will spare you the long walk, and you can enjoy the scenery and take photos from the plane wreck.
- **Thorsmörk Super Jeep tour** – join a Super Jeep tour into the fairytale like valley of Thorsmörk, where in the winter time, only the Super Jeeps have access to. The drive leads through Glacier rivers, into the sparsely forested area of the valley. Duration 5 – 6 hours.
- **Lava Center Hvolsvöllur** – the new exhibition about the volcanoes that surround the area: Hekla, Katla, and the famous Eyjafjallajökull, that erupted in 2010.
- **Skogar museum** – the largest folk museum in Iceland with collectibles from days gone by. Take a glimpse into the old turf farm and imagine the live of the first settlers.
- **The Lava tunnel Raufarhólshellir** – explore on this guided tour one of Iceland´s most spectacular lava caves.
